PRESS RELEASE: 10/17/18 Heroin -Related Arrest by Drug Task Force

October 18, 2018

On October 17, 2018, the Franklin County Drug Task Force and PSP Troop H Vice, while conducting an investigation into the distribution of heroin/fentanyl in the Chambersburg area, a search warrant was executed at Room 218 at the Red Roof Inn (1110 Sheller Avenue in Chambersburg). The search yielded approximately 100 grams of heroin/fentanyl and U.S. currency.

As a result, Daquan Dandre Seabrook, was arrested for possession with intent to deliver a controlled substance and use and or possession of drug paraphernalia. Seabrook was arrested thereafter at a location in Guilford Township, after he had left work while under surveillance of investigators.



Seabrook was taken to the Franklin County Booking Center and was later arraigned by Magisterial District Judge Duane Cunningham. Bail was set at \$250,000.

Agencies assisting in the investigation were the Franklin County D.A.'s Office, PSP Troop H Vice, Chambersburg Police Department, Shippensburg Police Department and the Washington Township Police Department.

The amount of controlled substances seized would equate to 4,000 doses of heroin/fentanyl if sold at the street level.
