Press Release – Drug Task Force Arrest Chambersburg Heroin Dealer

On June 1, 2016, the Franklin County Drug Task Force executed a search warrant at 62 Lincoln Way West, Chambersburg, PA. The search warrant was a result of a months-long investigation into the distribution of heroin by Quintin Noel Gordon, who resides at the address.

During the execution of the warrant, quantities of suspected heroin, cocaine, and crack cocaine were located within the residence. Drug paraphernalia used for the packaging and distribution of controlled substances was also found along with U.S. currency and a handgun. Gordon was subsequently arrested for felony firearm and drug trafficking-related offenses. MDJ Larry Pentz set bail at \$200,000 after Gordon was taken to the Franklin County Booking Center for arraignment.

Chambersburg Police Department and PSP-Chambersburg assisted with the investigation and execution of the warrant.
