SERVICE DOG APPLICATIONS OPEN FOR VETERANS

If you are a Franklin County Veteran who is in need and interested in applying for a service dog, please read the following information carefully to determine if you meet our eligibility requirements.

Franklin County Veterans Affairs provides service dogs to Veterans who:

- *have active duty service in any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces during any era; and
- *have received an honorable or a general (under honorable conditions) discharge; and
- *have a service-connected disability; and
- *have been released from **all** active service and reserve obligations; and
- *have met all Franklin County Veteran Affairs requirements for application into the program, applied, and have been accepted into the program

There is no cost to a Veteran for the service dogs we raise, train, and place, or for the training we provide.
