

**INVITATION TO BID**

Sealed bids for various bridge maintenance activities, including concrete deck repairs, concrete substructure repairs, sediment removal and steel beam painting at several different bridge sites around Franklin County will be received by the Franklin County Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, at the Franklin County Controller's Office, 218 North Second Street, Chambersburg, PA 17201 until 12:00 pm, Wednesday, August 3, 2016.

The bids will be publicly open and read on Thursday, August 4, 2016 at 9:40 am (prevailing time) at the Franklin County Commissioners' Office, 14 North Main Street, Chambersburg, PA 17201.

Copies of the bidding documents are on file, open to public inspection and may be obtained for a fee from C.S. A non-refundable check for \$30.00/paper copy or \$15.00/CD/Electronic Copy made payable to Franklin County shall be submitted as payment for each set of bidding documents requested. A bid bond by acceptable surety or a certified check made payable to Franklin County in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the maximum bid must be deposited by each bidder with his bid.

Each bidder must be prepared to submit evidence of his qualifications to perform the work.

Notice is hereby given to bidders that this project is subject to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act approved August 15, 1961 (Act No. 442, P.L. 987), as amended.

Bidders should refer to federal and state statutes, rules and regulations dealing with the prevention of environmental pollution and the preservation of public and natural resources pursuant to PA Act No. 1972-247.

The Contract Time for this project is two hundred sixty (260) calendar days.
