## SPECIFICATIONS

### Barn beam and cut limestone removal requirements:

- All wood (floor boards, horizontal and vertical beams, gates, lower loafing stall troughs, timbers, boards, etc.) are to be removed in their entirety from Franklin County barn property
- The cut limestone to be removed includes the barn foundation and barnyard limestone wall
- Access and temporary staging is available for truck, lift equipment, dumpster containers, etc. on site
- The successful bidder will be required to sign a waiver and release and provide evidence of acceptable insurance as required by Franklin County. Bidder removes the wood/beams at their own risk. The County is not responsible for bodily injury or property damage arising from their activities
- Unwanted cut stone may remain on site
- Removal of the barn beams and cut stone is not to interfere with County, PSU Ag. Ext. or related Ag. Ext. daily business or obstruct access onto or leaving the property at any time including emergency vehicles or responders
- Removal of the barn beams and cut stone may proceed from 7:00am to 8:00pm Monday through Saturday
- The wood and cut stone removal process is to be completed 30 days following notice of bid award
- The successful bidder is responsible to maintain the construction site safety while the removal process is underway. This includes daylight or night time hours when removal efforts are not underway.
