8. INCIDENT DETAILS <p>At approximately 0605 hours on 05/01/2014, members of the Pennsylvania State Police Special Emergency Response Team (SERT) and the Franklin County Drug Task Force executed a search warrant at 821 Siloam Road, in Greene Township, Franklin County. The search warrant was the result of an investigation into the distribution of heroin that began on March 15, 2014, when an anonymous complainant submitted a tip on Gordon through the Franklin County Drug Task Force website. Gordon was subsequently placed under surveillance by multiple law enforcement agencies and 821 Siloam Road was identified as his primary residence. Surveillance was then established on the residence and several known heroin users were observed visiting the residence. Informants were then used to make a series of controlled purchases of heroin from Gordon inside the residence and, based on the controlled purchases and surveillance, a search warrant for the residence was applied for and approved on 04/30/2014.</p> <p>During the search of the residence, investigators found heroin, crack cocaine, marijuana, prescription pills, US Currency, and paraphernalia associated with the processing, packaging, and use of controlled substances. A loaded Ruger LC9 pistol was also located in close proximity to the location of several of the drug items. Gordon is a previously convicted felon and is prohibited by statute from possessing firearms.</p> <p>As a result of this investigation, Gordon was charged with seven counts of Unlawful Delivery or Possession With Intent To Deliver a Controlled Substance, four counts of Criminal Use of Communications Facility, one count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and one count of Persons Not to Possess Firearms. The investigation is ongoing and additional arrests are anticipated.</p> <p>Gordon, who was a state parole absconder during the course of this investigation, was taken into custody following the execution of the search warrant and turned over to agents from the Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole. Criminal charges against Gordon were filed on 05/09/2014.</p> <p>The Pennsylvania State Police, the Franklin County District Attorney's Office, and the Chambersburg Borough Police participated in this investigation.</p> <p>Anyone with information pertaining to suspected drug activity occurring in Franklin County can contact the Franklin County Drug Task Force at 1-800-344-3127.
