

**OFFICIAL NOTICE of ELECTION**  
**For Military and Overseas Voters**  
**2018 General Election**  
**November 6, 2018**

This is an official notice of a General election to be conducted on November 6, 2018 in Franklin County. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA) available at [www.votespa.com](http://www.votespa.com) or [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov). You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by email to [voter@franklincountypa.gov](mailto:voter@franklincountypa.gov) or by fax to (717) 261-3131.

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for a candidate for U.S. Senate and U.S. Representative (Representative in Congress) as well as candidates for all state and local offices and ballot initiatives.

To vote, refer to page 3 of the FWAB.

To vote for U.S. Senate and U.S. Representative (Representative in Congress), write in the name of the candidate of your choice in the space provided on the FWAB.

To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the ballot initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for or if you are voting on a Referendum, write "Yes" or "No".

**Following are the offices on the ballot. The candidate list will be posted at a later time.**

**One (1) United States Senator** (6 Yr. Term) – All Precincts in Franklin Co.

**One (1) Governor /Lt. Governor** (4 Yr. Term) – All Precincts in Franklin County

**One (1) Representative in Congress from the 13th Congressional District** (2 Yr. Term) – All Precincts in Franklin County

**One (1) Senator in the General Assembly from the 30<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District** (4 Yr. Term) – Antrim Township, Fannett Township, Metal Township, Montgomery Township, Peters Township, St. Thomas Township, Warren Township, Greencastle Borough and Mercersburg Borough

**One (1) Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 78th Legislative District** (2 Yr. Term) – Includes Montgomery Township, Peters Township, Warren Township, and Mercersburg Borough

**One (1) Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 82nd Legislative District** (2 Yr. Term) – Includes Fannett Township, Metal Township and St. Thomas Township

**One (1) Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 89th Legislative District** (2 Yr. Term) – Includes Greene Township, Guilford Township, Lurgan Township, Southampton Township, Chambersburg Borough, Orrstown Borough, and Shippensburg Borough.

**One (1) Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 90th Legislative District** (2 Yr. Term) – Includes Antrim Township, Hamilton Township, Letterkenny Township, Quincy Township, Washington Township, Greencastle Borough, Mont Alto Borough, and Waynesboro Borough.
