

## Notice of Special Election

In accordance with 25 P.S. §2787 and §3041 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, notice is hereby given of a Special Election to be held in 49 precincts in Franklin County to fill a vacancy in the office of Senator in the General Assembly in the 33<sup>rd</sup> Senatorial District. The Special Election will be held concurrently with the normally scheduled May 21, 2019 Municipal Primary between the hours of 7:00 AM and 8:00 PM prevailing time.

ALL registered voters in these 49 precincts in Franklin County will be eligible to cast a ballot on May 21 regardless of their party affiliation on their voter registration record. These precincts include the municipalities of Chambersburg Borough, Greene Township, Guilford Township, Hamilton Township, Letterkenny Township, Lurgan Township, Mont Alto Borough, Orrstown Borough, Quincy Township, Southampton Township, Washington Township, Waynesboro Borough and West End-Shippensburg. The rest of the municipalities in Franklin County are part of the 30<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District and will not be voting in the Special Election race.

Voters who are registered with the Democratic or Republican parties will be eligible to vote on their respective party primary ballots to select party nominees to appear on the November ballot. They will also be eligible to vote in the special election to elect a Senator in the General Assembly.

Voters who are registered with all other political parties (Green, Independent, Libertarian, etc.) will be eligible to only vote in the special election to elect a Senator in the General Assembly.
