LOCAL ELECTION BOARD – ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Judge of Elections

The Judge of Elections is in charge of all activities and personnel inside the polling place on Election Day. The Judge opens and closes the polls and is responsible for returning results, documents and supplies to the County Election Board on Election Night.

Inspector of Elections

The Majority and Minority Inspectors will normally manage the District Register (also called poll books). The Minority Inspector also normally accompanies the Judge to the Administrative Annex in Chambersburg at the end of the day.

Clerk

Clerks are normally assigned to manage the Numbered List of Voters.
