DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR

VETERANS TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE (VTA) APPLICATIONS

- Copy of DD214 (Must be Member copy 2 or copy 4) We must be able to read the character of the discharge.
- An explanation of what has caused the financial setback. What event took place and what caused the unexpected loss of income? ** Remember, there has to have been a recent, unexpected "event" that has caused this financial setback.
- Proof of <u>household</u> income from <u>all sources</u> (copies of paystubs, bank statements, etc.) This also includes <u>documents to verify</u> child support income, V.A. benefits, Unemployment Compensation, Social Security, Disability, and any other sources of monthly income.
- Copies of all household bills. This includes utilities, car payments/insurance, phone bills, credit card bills, proof of housing costs (copy of lease or mortgage statement), medical bills, repair bills. These copies must be actual statements, <u>not</u> hand-written lists of bills.
- A copy of the applicant's marriage license/certificate, birth certificate and social security card for spouse. For a widow/widower or a dependent applicant of an eligible veteran, a copy of the veteran's death certificate.
- A copy of a birth certificate of the veteran's dependent children and if applicable, a copy of court orders indicating payment of child support.
- Include a copy of the applicant's recent, official, complete bank statement from all bank accounts. The banks can provide a copy, and it must show the complete, previous month's banking activities, from the 1st through the end of the month.
- If the grant is needed for a repair bill of any type, an <u>official</u> estimate or bill must be included with the request.
